November, 2011 - Instructions - Issued.

The Home Secretary, Government of India in the reference cited, has requested to observe the 'Communal Harmony Campaign Week' in the State from 19th to 25th November this year and the 'Flag Day' on 25th November, 2011 to take action accordingly. The principle objective of observing aforesaid week is to increase awareness regarding the importance of communal harmony and national integration amongst the people. The said campaign week be observed befittingly in all offices of the State by organizing cultural programmes, seminars, painting competitions etc., to effectively promote the values of communal harmony and national integration.

2. Accordingly, the State Government have decided to observe the 'Communal Harmony Campaign Week' 19.11.2011 to 25.11.2011 and the 'Flag Day' in the State on 25-11-2011.

All the Department of Secretariat, are therefore, requested to issue suitable instructions to the Heads of Departments, Public Sector Undertakings, All Schools, Colleges, Universities, Industrial Establishments and other Institutions/Organisations, under their Administrative control and to take all necessary action to observe the 'Communal Harmony Campaign Week' in all the Districts in the State **from 19.11.2011 to 25.11.2011** and the 'Flag Day' **on 25.11.2011** in their respective jurisdictions, as suggested by the Government of India, by associating the School/College students, for effective communication of the message of Communal Harmony and National Integration.

4. The Guidelines regarding arrangements required are indicated in the Annexure-I appended to this U.O.Note.

5. Further the sticker flags received from the National Foundation for Communal Harmony, New Delhi are sent herewith as indicated in the Annexure-II in connection with observance of Flag Day on 25.11.2011.

6. All the departments of Secretariat are, therefore, requested to raise the substantial funds by way of donations by distributing the flags to Staff/Officers of the Department.

7. They are also requested to follow the procedure/guidelines appended to this U.O.Note in raising of funds. The total amount collected may be remitted direct to the National Foundation for Communal Harmony, New Delhi, through a D.D./Cheque drawn in favour of the Secretary, NFCH, 9th Floor, 'C' Wing, Lok Nayak Bhavan, New Delhi-110 003 under intimation to this Department.
